McKinney-Vento Information for Parents

If your family lives in any of the following situations:

- In a shelter
- In a car, park, abandoned building, bus, or train station
- Doubled up with other people due to loss of housing or economic hardship Your school-age children may qualify for certain rights and protections under the federal McKinney-Vento Act.

Admission of Homeless Children and Youth This federal law ensures that the educational needs of homeless children and youth are met through immediate enrollment, comparable services, and supplemental services. All homeless children and youth must have equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including public preschool education, as provided to other children and youths and afford the opportunity to meet the same challenging state student academic achievement standards to which all students are held. Authority: McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, 42 U.S.C. 11431 et seq.
